It took nearly a year to learn how to walk. Crawls begat stumbles, stumbles begat false starts. Until one day, we became trapeze artists on the tight wire and took those baby steps that led to walking unassisted. Now, it has become as natural as breathing in and breathing out. Recently, I've been visiting with my father in a skilled nursing facility. Most days before going home for the day, I drop by and we go

through the ritual from wheelchair to walker. I have a newfound respect for our rehab folks, who assist patients in returning to some level of mobility. Instructions are given to keep his feet inside the walker as he places one foot in front of the other...

Life can take all kinds of twists and turns. Faith is a lot like that—placing one foot in front of the other. Retooling, relearning, stepping out into unknown futures, keeping our feet upon the path that God would have us to walk. Life often provides us choices. Which road should we take? How might we best achieve our goals, our hopes, and our dreams? Watching and coaching my father towards a road named Recovery, has given me pause to reflect upon my own health, my purpose, God's purpose for my life. Each new day presents so many opportunities. Staying connected, remaining engaged, doing those things that God would have us to do, don't come without a steadfast commitment to our own faith walking. Charlie

Duke once stated: *“I'm one of only twelve men to have ever walked upon the moon.
